3 DAY MALAKOFF DIGGINS GOLD RUSH PROGRAM

1st DAY

- 8:45 PM – STUDENTS GET READY FOR BED. ALL QUIET AT 10.

2nd DAY

- 7:00 AM = TIME TO RISE AND SHINE.
- 8:00 AM – BREAKFAST, FOLLOWED BY DISHWASING.
- 9:30 AM – STUDY GROUPS ASSEMBLE AND HEAD OUT FOR THE DIGGINS AND OTHER PARK DESTINATIONS LIKE HUMBUG CREEK FOR GOLD PANNING, THE BLAIR LAKE, OR THE TOWN CEMETERY. DURING THE HIKE STUDENTS LEARN ABOUT THE LOCAL ENVIRONMENT AND THE HISTORY OF THE GOLD RUSH.

- 8:45 PM – GET READY FOR BED, WITH ALL QUIET BY 10 PM.

3rd DAY

- 6:30 AM – EVERYONE UP TO PACK GEAR, CLEAN TENTS, AND BREAK DOWN CAMP.
- 8:00 AM – BREAKFAST, DISHWASHING, AND CAMP SWEEP.
